


REVIEW 2017 YEAR IN




We had such a crazy-busy 2017, and our success is all thanks to YOU! I thought every-paw-dy might want to know about all the puppies we fed, saved, and rehomed in 2017! So let me start off this letter from the beginning....

I can't believe all of this happened because I stole my mommy's heart on that cold December night in Sarajevo – heck, all I really wanted was a belly-rub!! The only life I knew was just roaming the streets, running out into a nearby field to play with other street dogs, and avoiding people who didn't like me. I guess that is the beauty of it all, that we never know the pawesome things that can come of the smallest of actions...! Thankfully mommy fell in love with me, and in doing so, saw how much I wanted to save my friends. Now I'm pursuing my dream!

Since I'm not that good with typing, numbers, or concentrating, you know, important things like that, I'll let my mommy finish the rest of this letter. Thank you ALL for your supportz and lovez and donations to help me save more of my Bosnian fur friends I left behind.

In 2017, we rehomed 125 Bosnian strays across the U.S. and 7 European countries! But our efforts didn't just begin once we became an official nonprofit. From 2015 – 2017, we've collectively rehomed 216 of Bosnia's forgotten street dogs!! Tanzie, 9 pups w/PRM, 4 w/ other volunteers, 175 through TTP, and 27 Nina rehomed independently in 2016.









I can't believe all of this happened because I stole my mommy's heart on that cold December night in Sarajevo!

As of June 2018, we've rehomed another 38 dogs - including our first in Canada! So since me, the first Bosnian rescue pup, you and other organizations have helped rescue and rehome 254 homeless Bosnian dogs in total - it's un-paw-lievable and paw-sitively fantastic!!

We won't ever be able to save them all, and that breaks my heart, but we have helped SO many that never would have been saved, fed, or cared for had we not had a paw in it. Thank you for helping me #savebosnianstrays...PAW-PUMP Team Tanzie!!

FINANCIALS

We launched our first fundraiser benefiting Bosnia's stray dogs in December 2014, when founder Katie asked her friends for \$500 to buy dog food - and the rest is history! It's amazing what we can all achieve when we come together for the common good!

To showcase our overall growth, we've also included 2015 & 2016 donation figures in this financial summary. Wow, we have made a huge impact since that first fundraiser more than three years ago!

TTP's key support areas entail veterinary expenses, food, shelter repairs and construction, pension (shelter) fees, and transport expenses.

TRANSPORTS: Expenses incurred relating to animal transport, including both animal and airfare; rates, ground transport services, passports, health certificates, travel supplies (leashes, harnesses, etc).

FOOD: Costs of dog food for animals at rescue partners' shelter or other private pensions.

VETERINARY CARE: Includes both surgical and nonsurgical expenses; requiring significant repair, such as due to injury or illness or vaccinations and medications, or treatments other than surgical.

SHELTER FEES & REPAIRS: All expenses related to operation and maintenance of rescue partners' shelters or fees paid to private shelters (pensions). This includes construction or improvement of facilities, and payment to shelter workers.

NON-VET/TRAVEL ANIMAL COSTS: Includes expenses related to Fairy Dog Parent program (food, shelter, or medicines for sponsored animal), and other supplies for animal not related to veterinary or transport.

ADMIN EXPENSES: Costs of various administrative and maintenance expenses, including payment fees (PayPal, Western Union, Stripe, WePay), monthly subscription services (Quickbooks, Social Pilot, Adobe Creative Cloud), annual website subscription and hosting, postage, phone, and related expenses.





Unfortunately, 5 of the 36 have since passed away from either illnesses or regretfully, altercations with other dogs – unfortunately one was a result of human cruelty at Praca shelter, where a fight was instigated intentionally.

Running free are Browny, Ginger, Miki, Glista, and although we aren't for certain, Dingo...after he had his surgery in Bosnia earlier this year, he ran away and has yet to be found. Although we are deeply saddened we could make all of our 36 dogs' furever dreams come true, because of you, we kept our promise to all we could.



Bosnian rescues Ice, Blue, Maya, and Odie joined their fearless leader for this historic moment!

Animal activists in Sarajevo asked fellow dog advocates across the globe to join them in hosting peaceful assemblies on Nov. 11, 2017, to bring world-wide awareness to the animal cruelty situation in Bosnia. We were extremely excited to honor their request. Tanzie and fellow Bosnian rescue pups held a "paw-test" outside of the Bosnian Embassy in Washington, D.C.

We requested the Bosnian government address the following issues relating to all homeless dogs:



Stop the inhumane killing and torture of all dogs in Bosnia.



Enforce humane treatment/conditions in all shelters across Bosnia.



Implement procedures allowing Bosnians citizens/ residents to enter any shelters to either volunteer, adopt, or see conditions. At the time, officials were threatening not to allow volunteers in Praca shelter.



dogs to eliminate potential for mass killing of dogs, where ear tag and microchip numbers are tracked and accounted for as dogs re transported to, from, or between shelters.

w requests and messages from native Bosnians thanking us for what we're doing to help the dogs in their country. Even though ent, our message IS working -- We're changing the Bosnian people's hearts and minds, one paw at a time!

"30-DAYS" RESCUE RECAP

What a whirlwind 4th quarter we had with our dear Nina! You all stuck through the craziness of the "30-day" shelter closure and thanks to you, we made miracles happen! Within the first 30 days, we transported 50 dogs - that effort bought us an additional 30 days from the animal inspection, and then another after that! In total, we transported 81 dogs between Nov. 19, 2017 and Feb. 15, 2018. WOWZA!

I know at times it seemed as if we had no idea what was going on...but it was organized chaos, we promise! Unfortunately not all of Nina's dogs got transported during that campaign -- all total, 14 dogs remained after the big push. We either didn't find homes in the rest of the momentum, or they were too sick or scared to travel.

Some of those dogs are still at Nina's - Lija, Benton, Gurda, Joka, Phoenix, Djecak, Meli, while the rest, Ghandi and Birdie, are placed in fosters. Not one dog is outside in her kennels anymore -- a concept we never thought possible!

When Katie first met and started working with Nina in 2015, she was caring for more than 200 dogs between her house and several private shelters (pensions).

An important update we need to share with all of you...although we moved the dogs from Nina's kennels, she still has 10 at a private shelter (Austin, Dexter, Hame, Joy, Maggie, Ollie, Persy, Rocky, Ruby, Sam). We were aware of these dogs, but shifted focus away from them during the "30-day" crisis. We realize we should have mentioned these dogs when we were moving all of the rest, but with the urgency of the situation, we had to focus all efforts to dogs at Nina's shelter due to their impending capture.

We hope it's evident our intent wasn't to withhold these additional dogs from our supporters, but to place emphasis on the most urgent need at the time. Now, we have refocused on getting those dogs out of that pension through fosters or adopters so they can have the wonderful new lives the 81 before them have!

LOOKING AHEAD



RESCUE PARTNERS

Thankfully, our work to save Bosnian dogs has brought so much awareness that we've decided to expand our support to additional rescue partners! Having 11 total, here's a brief intro to our 7 new partners in saving Bosnian strays!

GLADNO POLJE: A public shelter in Sarajevo, ran by a local Bosnian and American living in Sarajevo. We've helped find homes for several of their dogs...Julia, Lucky, Teddy & Lila!

SILVER DOG RESCUE: Located in the town of Srebrenica (srebro means "silver" in Bosnian), our new rescue partner is starting to build his very own shelter, and we're fundraising for the fence!

ANIMALS WE CARE MOSTAR: An official Bosnian nonprofit, this group of dog lovers in one of Bosnia's most recognizable cities (thanks to the Mostar bridge!) is working hard to save as many dogs as possible. We're supporting them through adoption postings.

We're also supporting individual rescuers in the Bosnian towns of Bihac, Tuzla, and Sarajevo, as well as Americans supporting dogs based in Bosnia and Serbia.

INACTIVE: While we still have a valid agreement with the unofficial shelter, Bosnian Dream Rescue, they haven't requested our assistance in close to a year, so this partnership is currently inactive.
