A NOTE FROM TANZIE

Tanzie here! Paw my gosh, I can't believe it's been another year of "pawmazing" work to #savebosnianstrays! We couldn't rescue and rehome these precious pups without your generosity and help!

As I hope you know, everything I do is with a heartfelt commitment to save my homeless fur-friends in Bosnia. Although I usually start my annual "repawts" with a highlight of activities during that specific year, I would first like to take a moment to acknowledge events impacting our world as of this report's publishing (August 2020).

The COVID-19 pandemic has unfortunately caused major impacts across our global community of supporters, pet parents, volunteers, and partners since the beginning of 2020. Our hearts go out to all those who've been impacted.

The pandemic has caused interruptions to our team's normal operations, most significantly with adoptions and transports. As COVID-19 continues to evolve worldwide, I'd like to reiterate our steadfast commitment to doing our part to help ensure the health and safety of the global community.

My team continues to monitor travel restrictions and our resulting ability to rehome Bosnian animals to loving families across Europe, Canada, and the United States. As you may already know, we are only processing animal adoptions and transports to countries allowing commercial transports. This also means we are experiencing significant delays in processing adoptions while we adjust to changing regulations and requirements. We are continuing to support Bosnian animals with food, shelter, and veterinary needs. Thank you in advance for your support of those upcoming initiatives.

We are also experiencing delays in our administrative tasks. Our Executive Team of volunteers is also navigating how to balance work and family life in this new world. Some things



we're normally on-top of (for example, this annual report) are taking longer than expected to complete, so we greatly "paw-preciate" your understanding as we also adjust to evolving environments.

Your unwavering support has allowed us to overcome challenges in the past, and we humbly ask for that same passion and dedication in our efforts to resume "normal" operations.

Thankfully, we are still accomplishing many wonderful things, and are excited to reflect on 2019! Thanks to you, in 2019 we raised **more than \$46,000 to support Bosnian strays!** Your 2019 donations helped **transport 42 former Bosnian street dogs to new families** across the globe: 23 to Germany, 6 to the UK, 5 to the USA, 5 to Denmark, 1 to Austria, and 2 to Belgium - our very first Bosnian-Belgian rescues!

We also covered nearly **\$5,000 in veterinary expenses**, including surgeries, medications, vaccinations, and transport paperwork. This included Bianca's wheelchair, medication for Livi's eye infection, Roby and Nicky's surgeries, and regular vetting expenses.

Additionally, your donations helped to purchase **\$5,300 worth of dog food**, which fed 44 shelter dogs for the entire year!

It's our honor and privilege to be your friend and partner in animal rescue, and we thank you for being at the heart of what we do.

RESCUE RECAP

Here's just a few highlights from a busy 2019:
funding surgeries, food, shelter fees, and more!

Livi & Bianca

These two sweet strays stole all of our hearts in September and October. Livi was found with a massive eye infection and in need of treatment and surgery; and Bianca was found after being hit by a car and unable to walk, in need of surgery and a wheelchair. Thanks to you, we funded surgery for both, and Livi was able to keep her eye! As of this report, both have found homes: Livi in Austria and Bianca in Germany!



Coco & Roki

Extremely leery of people, Roki lived in the woods outside Srebrenica with a festering neck wound for 2 years. In February, he mustered up the courage to trust humans and ventured into town for help. During surgery to remove dead flesh, the vet found a wire around his neck and three bullets lodged inside. Coco was attacked near the Srebrenica shelter and was left with a broken leg. Thanks to your generous donations, both Coco and Roki were able to get much needed vet care and improve their lives!



The "Secret Mission" Transport!

Team Tanzie, you came together in March to accomplish a seemingly "impawisible" mission - raise more than \$2K and send 7 pups - Harriet, Bake, Nina, Hope, Roxina, Snowy, Meggy, and Kiki - to foster and furever homes in Germany, Austria, and Denmark...and you DID IT!



Roby

Hi, Roby here! Nina found me as a puppy - my rear legs were injured and I was unable to walk properly. Thanks to your generosity, I was able to get hip surgery in Serbia! I'm walking much better now, and as of this report, I'm in a foster home in Austria! Thank you for helping me live my best life!



Vaccines & Food

In March our rescue partner in Srebrenica came across several scrawny, sickly puppies in need of food and medicines. Thanks to your "suppawt," all these puppies received proper vaccines and food to get them started on the road to recovery!



FINANCIALS

Our work to #savebosnianstrays starts with supporting individuals and organizations in Bosnia who we call Rescue Partners (or should we say, "paw-tners")! We support rescuers in the Bosnian towns of Bihac, Tuzla, Sarajevo, and Srebrenica, as well as Americans supporting dogs based in Bosnia.

We launched our first fundraiser benefiting Bosnia's stray dogs in Dec. 2014, when founder Katie was deployed to Sarajevo with the U.S. Air Force. Katie was heartbroken at the sight of so many hungry, stray dogs. She launched a GoFundMe and raised over \$1K to buy dog food! A few weeks later she fell in love with a sweet stray named Tanzie, and the [rest is history!](#)

To showcase our overall growth, we've also included 2015-2019 financials in this summary. Wow, we have made a huge impact since that first fundraiser more than six years ago!

TTP's two program areas are Animal Rescue and Animal Welfare. Animal Rescue entails travel and foster/forever home travel expenses, and Animal Welfare includes veterinary expenses, food, shelter repairs and construction, and shelter fees.

TRANSPORTS: Expenses incurred relating to animal transport, including animal airfare, ground transport

services, passports, health certificates, travel supplies (leashes, harnesses, etc).

FOOD: Costs of dog food for animals at rescue partners' shelter or other private pensions. This includes food revenues and expenses directly related to the Fairy Dog Parent program.

VETERINARY CARE: Includes both surgical and non-surgical expenses; whether for significant treatment or repair due to injury or illness; or routine vaccinations, medications, or treatments other than surgical.

SHELTER FEES & REPAIRS: All expenses related to operation and maintenance of rescue partners' shelters, or fees paid to private shelters (pensions). This also includes construction or improvement of facilities, and payment to shelter workers.

OTHER ANIMAL WELFARE COSTS: Includes expenses for animal supplies not related to food, veterinary, or transport expenses (potty pads, vitamins blankets, etc).

ADMIN EXPENSES: Costs of payment processing and bank fees; software/subscription services (accounting, marketing, shelter database); website subscription and hosting; postage; phone; and related expenses.

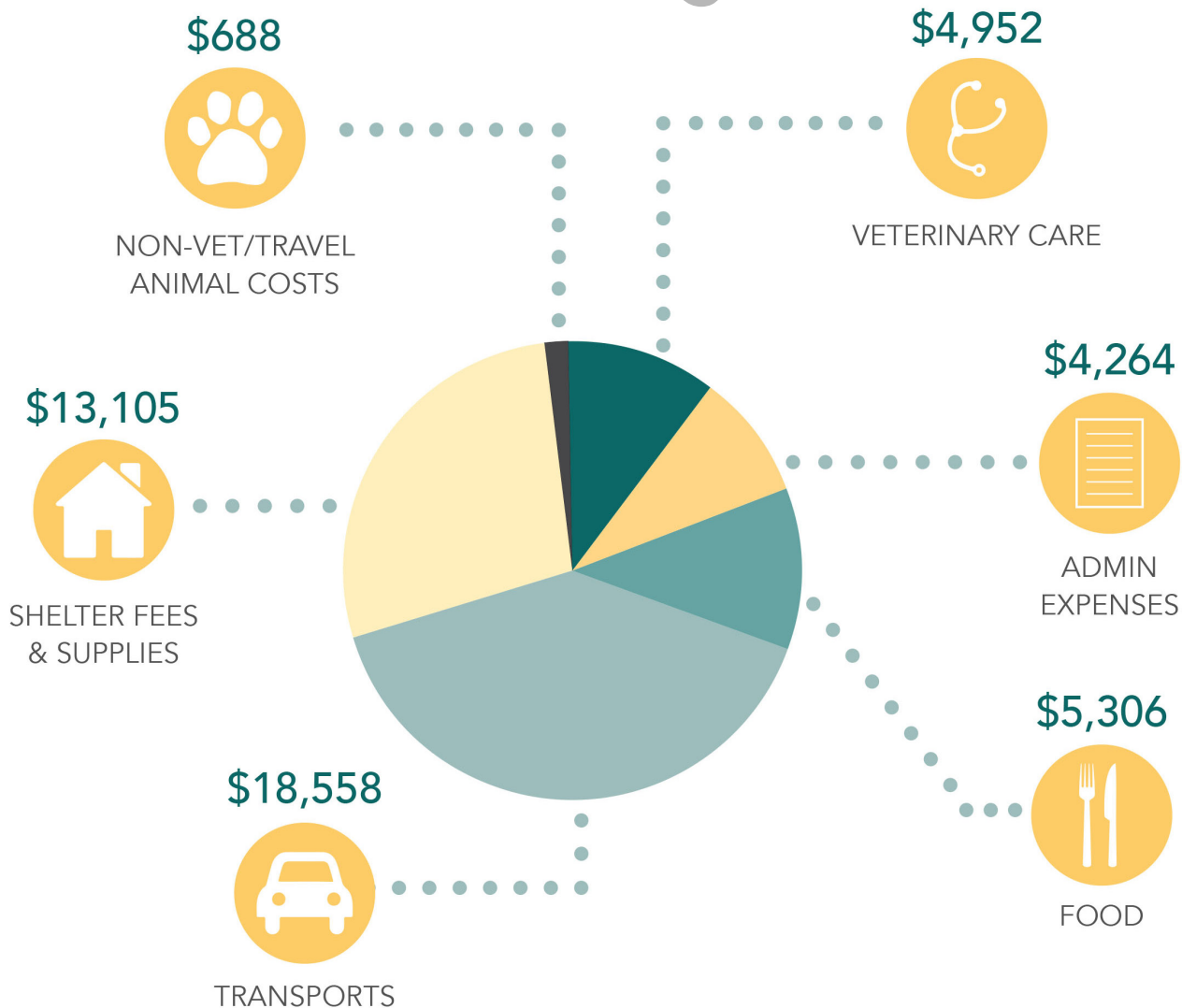

Don't worry - we don't overspend!

Hi, Tanzie again! I "pawmise" everyone that I know how to manage money! I asked my mommy to explain **why our fiscal year (FY) 2018 and 2019 financial data shows "losses"**:

Let's say we collect donations Dec. 30, 2018 (FY18), for Rex to travel to the USA. Rex doesn't actually leave for another month, so we don't "spend" those donations until Jan. 2019 (FY19), occurring the next fiscal year.

For accounting purposes, Rex's transport donations would be counted as revenue for FY18, but the corresponding

travel expense would occur in FY19, making FY19 numbers show we "spent" more than we "earned."

Tanzie's FY19 finances show a loss because we received transport donations for Rex and Meli in Dec. 2018, but they didn't travel until Jan. 2019.

FY18 shows a loss due to transport donations also being received in Dec. 2017, with expenses occurring the next FY. These transports were for Bambi and Donna, who traveled in Feb. 2018; and the "30 Days to Save Strays" dogs, who we transported from Nov. 2017 to Feb. 2018 when our Sarajevo rescuer, Nina, had to close her shelter.

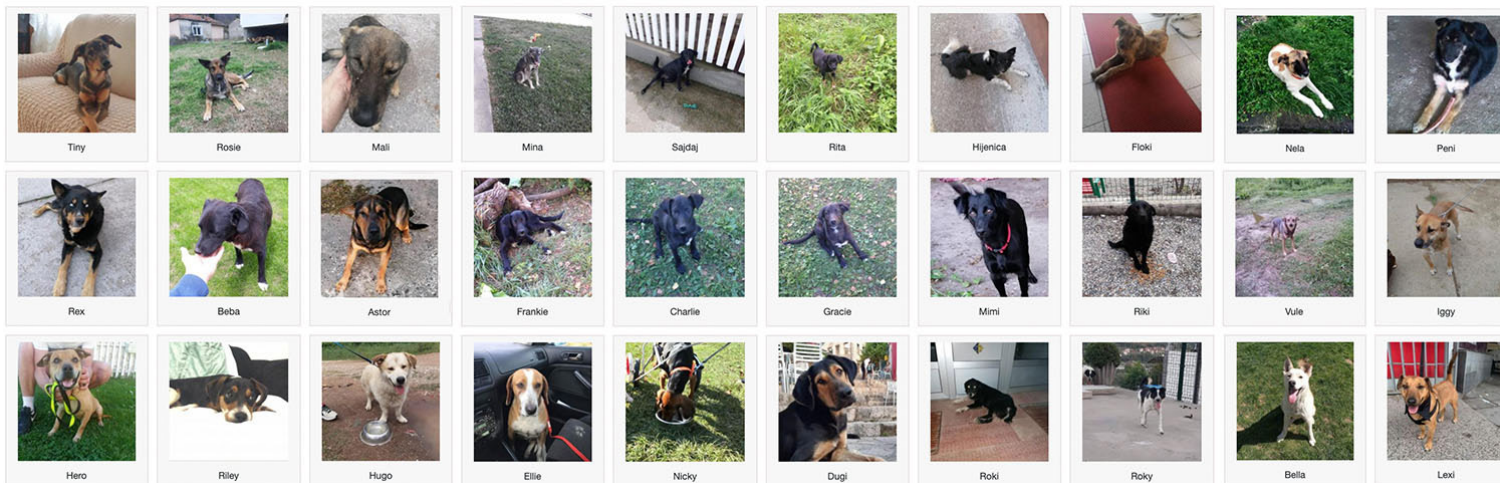


Funjo

RESCUE PARTNERS

As you know, our programs support individual rescuers and organizations in the Bosnian towns of Srebrenica, Bihac, Tuzla, and Sarajevo, including:

SILVER DOG SREBRENICA: Located in the town of Srebrenica (srebro means "silver" in Bosnian), SDS is an official nonprofit and working with the municipality to build a shelter (see "Happy Tails" entry below!). Now in our second year of partnership, our work continues with providing food, veterinary, and shelter support.

ANIMALS WE CARE MOSTAR: An official Bosnian nonprofit, AWC is located in one of Bosnia's most recognizable cities (thanks to the Mostar bridge!) and is working hard to save as many dogs as possible. We're supporting them through adoption postings and transports.

RECURRING "FUN-RAISERS"

Each month we support more than 60 street and shelter dogs with food and private shelter fees (known as "pansions/pensions") to keep dogs healthy and safe until they find their "forever homes." Together, these expenses total roughly \$1,700.
